



CALIFORNIA AND EPA EMISSION CONTROL WARRANTY STATEMENT YOUR WARRANTY RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are pleased to explain the emission control system warranty on your 2007-2009 Model Year off-road Large Spark-Ignition (LSI) engine. New off-road LSI engines must be designed, built and equipped to meet stringent anti-smog standards in all 50 states. Hyster Company must warrant the emission control system on your engine for the periods of time listed below provided there has been no abuse, neglect or improper maintenance of your engine.

WARRANTY COVERAGE

Model Year 2007-2009 off-road LSI engines are warranted for 3 years or 2,500 hours, whichever occurs first to be free of defects in material or workmanship of any emission related part, unless indicated otherwise. If any emission-related part on your engine is defective, the part will be repaired or replaced.

Your emission control system may include parts such as the Liquid Petroleum Gas (LPG) mixer and regulator, fuel-injection system, ignition system, engine control module, catalytic converter and air induction system. **Also included may be sensors, hoses, belts, connectors, and other emission-related assemblies.**

- Vacuum, temperature, and time-sensitive valves and switches
- Sensors used for electronic controls
- Hoses, belts, connectors, assemblies, clamps, fittings, tubing, wiring, sealing gaskets or devices, and mounting hardware
- Pulleys, belts and idlers

* Covered for 5 years or 3,500 hours of operation, whichever occurs first-Mazda only

** Covered for 5 years or 3,500 hours of operation, whichever occurs first-GM and Mazda

Where a warrantable condition exists, Hyster Company will repair your LSI engine at no cost to you including diagnosis, parts and labor.

OWNER'S WARRANTY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- As the off-road LSI engine owner, you are responsible for the performance of the **required maintenance listed in your owner's manual**. Hyster Company recommends that you retain all receipts covering maintenance on your off-road engine, but Hyster Company cannot deny warranty solely for the lack of receipts or your failure to ensure the performance of all scheduled maintenance.
- As the off-road LSI engine owner, you should however be aware that Hyster Company may deny you warranty coverage if your off-road LSI engine or a part has failed due to tampering, abuse, neglect, improper maintenance or unapproved modifications to the engine or fuel control system.
- Your engine is designed to operate on **LPG or Gasoline** as applicable. To confirm the fuel(s) this engine is capable of operating on, see the Emission Control Information label located under hood.
- LPG engines and fuel systems are designed to operate on HD-5 or HD-10 specification LPG fuel. Fuel other than HD-5 or HD-10 may cause harm to the engine's emission control system and a warranty claim may be denied on this basis if operators can readily find the proper fuel. Use of any other fuel may result in your engine no longer operating in compliance with CARB or EPA emissions requirements.
- You are responsible for initiating the warranty process. CARB and EPA suggest that you present your off-road LSI engine to a Hyster Company authorized dealer as soon as a problem exists. The warranty repairs should be completed by the dealer as expeditiously as possible.

ITEMS NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY

The following items are not covered under the Hyster Company warranty:

- Repairs as a result of improper maintenance or use
- Repairs made by unauthorized technicians, service stations, or dealers
