

ITC II Trucking Responsibilities

1. Beginning with the first show in April, have the units delivered to the hosting dealer at least 2 days prior to the show date. When dropping off the trailer the driver will need to stay there backed up to the loading dock until the dealer unloads the trucks. Once the trucks are unloaded, the hosting dealer will show the driver where to take the empty trailer for storage until pick up.
2. Pick up will need to take place at 3:00 pm on the last day of the show.

Example: The first show dates are April 26-27.

- The trailer will need to be **delivered** no later than April 24 to the hosting dealer.
- The trailer will need to be **picked up** at 3:00 pm on 4-24-07 and backed up to the loading dock.

The driver will wait while the units can be loaded up and secured properly **by the hosting dealer**. Once secured the driver will need to go to the next hosting dealer location and deliver the trailer.

3. It is critical to pick up the trailer and immediately get going to the next hosting dealer location. The hosting dealer will unload the units and have the driver move the trailer somewhere in the yard for storage.
4. We expect all show dates to be met – no exceptions.
