

Product Nomenclature Guide

For many, the lift truck of choice has always been a Hyster lift truck. Deciding which one is best for your operation won't be easy. We offer over 90 models configured for gasoline, LPG, diesel, compressed natural gas or electric power with the broadest capacity range in the industry.

Each Hyster truck is labeled with a model number. What does each one mean? Plenty. For example, you can determine whether the truck is a gasoline powered and a sit-down, counterbalanced rider. Simply use the "alpha" character in the model name to help you decipher it. Here's a list of "alpha" designations to help you.

E - Electric: counterbalanced, cushion tire lift truck

S - SpaceSaver: counterbalanced, I.C., cushion tire, sit-down lift truck

H - Challenger: counterbalanced, I.C., pneumatic tire, sit-down lift truck

J - Electric: counterbalanced, pneumatic tire, sit-down lift truck

R - OrderPicker: electric, stand-up lift truck

N - Narrow-Aisle: electric, stand-up lift truck

W - Walkie or Walkie Stackers: electric low lift pallet truck or electric high lift pallet truck

B - Walkie/Rider: electric pallet truck

C - Center Control Rider: electric pallet truck

T - Tractor: electric, tow tractor

RS - ReachStacker: counterbalanced, I.C., pneumatic tire, sit-down container handler

HR - YardMaster: counterbalanced, I.C., pneumatic tire, sit-down container handler
